

Academic Code of Ethics of the AGH University of Krakow

(Resolution of the AGH University Senate no. 35/2003)

The AGH University academic community, aware of the impact of science, education, and technology on the quality of human life, faithful to academic and social duties, obliged to abide by ethical rules at work and adhere to the highest academic standards, declares to the following:

1. Uphold the good name of AGH University and promote it in any place and in any form.
2. Be diligent and honest in the transfer of knowledge, especially in the evaluation of student' performance.
3. Be fair in research and academic criticism.
4. Be a kind-hearted supervisor and teacher to students and young academics.
5. Respect ethical standards in the external use of the university's research, educational, and organisational output.
6. Maintain integrity in the use of material and immaterial assets of AGH University in academic work. Do not perform work for external entities or use the AGH University's image for personal purposes on university premises without prior authorisation or agreement.
7. Avoid real or potential conflicts of interest and actions that could undermine the integrity and authority of the university.
8. Foster public awareness of the achievements of science and technology and promptly disclose any risks to people and the environment.
9. Oppose to all forms of academic and social misconduct.
